Candidates do not require experience with the Board and will serve a two year term.

Secretary: Duties include: attend Board meetings; record minutes at each Board meeting; serve on an initiative committee; and submit an annual report to the members; attend Annual Conference.

Regional Representative: Duties include: attend Board meetings; be a liaison between TNP and the local/regional members; serve on an initiative committee; and submit an annual report to the members; attend Annual Conference.

Diversity: In principle and in practice, TNP values and seeks diversity within the nurse practitioner field and promotes involvement and access to leadership opportunities to all members regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, religion, sexual orientation, nationality, or disability.

Elected Board members, with the exception of the President, may not serve more than two consecutive terms in the same position and no more than six consecutive years in any position on the Board.
